## **Different Trains**

The Ligeti Quartet present a brand new arrangement of Poppy Nogood and the Phantom Band - a cornerstone recording of the late 60s psychedelic era - for amplified string quartet and dnb Soundscape, alongside accompanying works. This is presented alongside deep listening legend, Pauline Oliveros, and Steve Reich's iconic *Different Trains* for his 90th Birthday in 2026. The quartet also present a re-imagining of Justė Janulytė's 2018 work for four string quartets. In the original, the groups are placed around the audience, forming a square, whilst the music moves in circular patterns. In this new version, the Ligeti Quartet perform amplified with three pre-recorded layers played back in quadraphonic speaker formation.
